- 1. The Government of Jammu and Kashmir through Government of India has applied for financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Jhelum Tawi Flood Recovery Project (JTFRP).
- 2. Rajbagh Silk factory is one of the state-owned properties severely affected in the floods. Maharaja Hari Singh set up the factory in 1939 for throwing, warping, weaving and finishing of Mulberry silk. Originally built on an area of 114 kanals, the factory had around 130 looms installed with a production capacity of 20000 meters of silk per month. However currently the Factory has now been confined in a large piece of land covering an area of 23 kanals. The current site of the Rajbagh factory has a total of 11 structures, the three main sheds (Structure A: Throwing Section, Structure B: Warping Section and Structure C: Weaving Section) oriented in the N-S direction. The other structures on the site include the Electrical Department, Mechanical Department, Workers Union, Canteen, Masjid as well as the Showroom. As part of the JTFRP building A is being rebuilt.
- 3. As part of the overall development of the site the Project Management Unit (PMU) of Jehlum Tawi Flood Recovery Project JTFRP is seeking consultancy services for preparation and supervision of a Conservation/restoration and adaptive reuse plan for Rajbagh Silk Factory in line with its vision and priorities for J&K's silk sector, and in a manner that preserves the factory's industrial heritage.
- 4. The consultancy consists of two parts:
  - Part A: Scoping visit to understand J&K's silk sector, historical background, current and future vision for GSWFR.
  - Part B: Conservation/Restoration and Adaptive Reuse of Government Silk Factory Rajbagh. Part B is further divided into two Phases:
    - o Phase I pertains to detailed site survey and generated of the site specific relevant data and design and development of a Conservation/Restoration and Adaptive Reuse masterplan for Rajbagh Silk Factory.
    - o Phase II pertains to oversight of contractors in a managerial / supervisory role to ensure timely and quality implementation of work(s) identified in Phase I.
- 5. PMU now invites eligible agencies/consultancy firms to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested consultants/firms should provide information demonstrating that

they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the tasks(Annexure A). The shortlisting criteria are:

- Consultant must have experience in the area for restoration, conservation and design of interpretation centres,
- Experience in design of adaptive re-use of heritage properties and retail design will be a plus
- Consultant shall have experience in preparation of cultural heritage sites restoration/rehabilitation designs in at least three contracts, that has been completed within the last five years and which are similar to the proposed assignment by physical size, nature of works, complexity, methods and technology.
- One of the key team members of the firm/company shall be a Conservation Architect
- Must be in business from last 10 years.
- Must have average annual turnover of Rs 75 Lakhs during the last 3 years.
- Prior work experience in sector of cultural heritage in the state of Jammu and Kashmir will be a plus.
- 6. The attention of interested consultancy firms is drawn to paragraph 1.9 of the World Bank's *Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants [under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants] by World Bank Borrowers, January 2011 modified in July 2014* ("Consultant Guidelines"), setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest. - 7. Consultants/Firms may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture to enhance their qualifications. However formation of consortium among firms/consultancies is not accepted. Further lead partner should at least satisfy 50% and JV partner should satisfy at least 25% of the average annual turnover and overall the lead and joint venture should satisfy 100% of the requisite turnover for the last 3 years.
- 8. A consultant/Firm will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost Based Selection Method (QCBS) method set out in the Consultant Guidelines.
