- 1. The Government of Jammu and Kashmir through Government of India has applied for financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Jhelum Tawi Flood Recovery Project (JFTRP).
- 2. The state government, over the years, has, undertaken various projects to build artisan capacity, improve linkages and spur development of the sector. Unfortunately, 2014 floods resulted in damage to infrastructure and assets such as workshops, stores, tools, raw material and finished product stocks, which severely impacted non-farm livelihoods in urban centre.
- 3. After the 2014 floods, the state government, with the support of the World Bank has embarked on several initiatives in J&K's handloom and handicrafts sector, given the traditional importance of this sector and its significant economic potential. Along with restoring critical infrastructure, the project also aims to restore and strengthen non-farm livelihoods of those affected by the 2014 floods. One such initiative that is being undettaken is to initiate training of Artisans associated Willow Wicker, Paper Mache, Crewel Stitch embroidery and Wool in Product Development Cycle for National and International Market Linkages.
- 4. The Project Management Unit(PMU) of Jhelum Tawi Flood Recovery Project (JFTRP) is seeking an consultancy firm to carry establish marketing linkages for the artisans of the State particularly of those associated with the clusters of willow wicker, paper machie, crewel chainstitch and wool clusters where in end to end cluster development activities are being carried out. The objective of the consultancy is training of Artisans in Product Development Cycle for International Market Linkages in Willow Wicker, paper mache, crewel stitch embroidery and Wool of Jammu & Kashmir, including skill up gradation, design / product development, creating marketing linkages, building pipeline of orders for artisan institutions and facilitating participation in international marketing events.
- 5. The broad tasks involved in this exercise will be as follows:
  - Diagnostic Study and Intervention Plan
  - Skill Up-gradation and Capacity Building of the artisans
  - New Product Development and Training
  - Marketing Activities and support.
  - Facilitation in Production and infrastructure development with the cluster
  - Formation and development of sustainable business within the cluster

- 6. PMU now invites eligible consultancy firms to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested consultancy firms should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the tasks(Annexure A). The shortlisting criteria are:
  - At least 20 years of organizational experience in cluster development and promoting and marketing artisan products, preferably in natural fibre and wool based products.
  - Facilitated marketing of at least 5 million USD( 35.0 crores)worth of artisan products in last 10 financial years
  - Experience of working with at least 10000 artisans across the globe with specific experience of working in India as well as in other South Asian countries.
  - Proven track record in participating in major exhibitions nationally or internationally
  - Fair trade accreditation.
  - Prior experience of working with UNDP, ADB, World Bank, Ford Foundation, USAID or any other multilateral development agency supported/funded projects.
  - Prior experience of facilitate producer group participation in fairs such as New York Now, Santa Fe craft market, Ambiente etc.
- 7. The attention of interested consultancy firms is drawn to paragraph 1.9 of the World Bank's *Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants [under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants] by World Bank Borrowers, January 2011 modified in July 2014* ("Consultant Guidelines"), setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.
